Next Generation Success

Study Stars Afterschool Program

Evaluation of the 2022-2023 Study Stars Afterschool Program (Study Stars) was completed and demonstrates the continued success this support is having on youth academic achievement. From the student and parent surveys:

70 percent of students

responded that the i-Ready program, CHW's digital literacy program, helped them become better readers 92 percent of parents indicated that teachers noticed their child's reading had improved since being in the Study Stars program "I like the learning center because they help me with my math and reading homework. I also like the activities and games we play that help us learn." - CHW Afterschool Program Student

In addition to academic support and mentorship, CHW provides every student in the afterschool program with a healthy snack each day. Four CHW communities have also partnered with Heaven's Windows to provide additional healthy meals to youth residents.

Healthy Food Distribution

Health & Wellness has partnered with 4CommunityCare to provide monthly farmers' markets for our Poway cluster, bringing in much-needed healthy groceries to the thousands of residents who call this community home. This resource is provided at no cost to residents and has been so popular that the food is typically completely gone within the first hour.

The YFLP is a six-month program focused on six sessions: Banks and Banking, Credit, Mastering Your Money, College and Universities, Alternatives to College, and Loans. Some benefits Angel has been gaining from the YFLP is learning about economics, understanding and maintaining credit scores, and saving money for important future expenses, such as buying a house.

Angel received much support from Rodrigo Gomez, one of CHW's Financial Well-Being Coaches, as he led Angel through the YFLP workshops. Angel looks forward to keeping in touch with Rodrigo because of his great experience with accounting and investing.
